COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Recommendation on Sufficiency and Proposed Procedural Schedule.

I. BACKGROUND

On May 18, 2017, Frognot Water Supply Corporation (Frognot) applied amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 10164 in Collin, Hunt and Fannin Counties by transferring existing customers and facilities from the North Farmersville Water Supply Corporation to Frognot, and for dual certification in certain areas with North Farmersville WSC, Caddo Basin SUD, and, West Leonard WSC.

Order No. 2 restyled this matter as a Sale, Transfer, or Merger Application (Application) and included North Farmersville WSC (Farmersville) as a co-applicant. Order No. 3 allowed Staff until August 25, 2017 to make a recommendation on sufficiency.

II. RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY

As noted in the Attached memorandum of Emily Sears of the Water Utilities Division, Staff has reviewed the Applicants' filings and recommends that the Application is sufficient for filing. Staff further recommends the applicants issue notice. The attached memorandum provides instructions on issuing notice and providing proof of notice. Also attached is a sample notice and affidavit of notice.



III. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULULE

On May 18, 2017, Frognot Water Supply Corporation (Frognot or Applicant) applied to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 10164 in Collin, Hunt and Fannin Counties. The application was filed pursuant to §§ 13.242-13.250, and 13.301 of the Texas Water Code (TWC) and 16 Texas Administrative Code §§ 24.8, 24.101 - 24.107, and 24.109 (TAC).

The Applicant has requested to transfer customers and facilities from North Farmersville Water Supply Corporation to the Applicant, to obtain dual certification with North Farmersville Water Supply Corporation, to obtain dual certification with Caddo Basin Special Utility District, and to obtain dual certification with West Leonard WSC.

A Staff review of the additional information filed by the applicant on July 19, 2017, found that it is sufficient in the required application and mapping information. Therefore, Staff recommends that the application be deemed sufficient for filing and found administratively complete. Staff further recommends the Applicant be ordered to do the following:

- 1) Provide notice of the application to the following:
 - a) any districts, utilities, and cities within two (2) miles of the requested area;
 - b) the county judge of each county and each groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partly included in the requested area to be certified;
 - c) each city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) that is wholly or partly included in the requested area to be certified; and
 - d) existing customers.
- 2) Provide correct notice of the application to the following entities:
 - Caddo Basin SUD (CCN No. 10165)
 - City of Blue Ridge (CCN No. 13123)
 - City of Farmersville
 - Collin County Judge
 - Desert WSC (CCN No. 10158)
 - Fannin County Judge

Frognot Water Supply Corporation (WSC) has filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for CCN No. 10164 for the provision of retail water utility service in Collin, Hunt, and Fannin Counties. Frognot WSC is also requesting to transfer existing customers and facilities from the North Farmersville Water Supply Corporation, and for dual certification in certain areas with North Farmersville Water Supply Corporation, Caddo Basin Special Utility District, and West Leonard Water Supply Corporation.

The requested area is comprised of two areas (northern and southern).

The northern area is located approximately <u>3</u> miles <u>north</u> of downtown <u>Blue Ridge</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>Fannin CR 5005</u>; on the east by <u>Fannin CR 5005</u>; on the south by the <u>Collin/Fannin County Line</u>; and on the west by the <u>Collin/Fannin County Line</u>.

The southern area is located approximately 5 mile(s) north of downtown Farmersville, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Collin CR 618; on the east by Collin CR 703; on the south by Collin CR 617; and on the west by SH 78.

The sale is scheduled to take place as approved by the Commission (V.T.C.A., Water Code § 13.301). The transaction and the transfer of customers and facilities includes the following area: southern, as described above.

This transaction will have the following effect on the <u>11</u> current customers' rates and services: Customers will be charged different rates than they were charged before the transaction.

The total requested area includes approximately 1,330 acres.

A request for a public hearing must be in writing and include: (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the Utility's name, docket number or another recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement, "I/we request a public hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent, would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the

application which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
