**ORDER NO. 1  
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND  
FILING AND SERVICE PROCEDURES**

This Order addresses CommZoom, LLC’s application filed under Public Utility Regulatory Act § 66.003 (PURA)<sup>1</sup> for approval to amend its State-Issued Certificate of Franchise Authority (SICFA) No. 90086. Applicant seeks to expand its service area footprint to include the municipal boundaries of the Cities of Jourdanton, Poteet, and Three Rivers, Texas.

**I. Procedural Schedule**

Under PURA § 66.003, the Commission must issue the SICFA before the 17th business day after the filing of a complete and sufficient application. Accordingly, the following procedural schedule shall apply in this project:

Commission requests <i>Texas Register</i> to announce application	May 22, 2017
Commission Staff files recommendation re: sufficiency/approval	June 5, 2017
<i>Texas Register</i> publication	June 2, 2017
If application is found insufficient, Commission issues order and resets the procedural schedule	June 9, 2017
Order to approve or dismiss application	June 13, 2017
