ORDER NO. 3
FINDING APPLICATION REMAINS INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's July 31, 2017, supplemental recommendation that the Union Grove Water Supply Corporation's application remains deficient and incomplete. This application was deemed deficient on June 28, 2017.

Commission Staff continues to recommend that the application remains administratively incomplete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's pleadings and attached memorandums of Jolie Mathis and Tracy Montes in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff also continues to propose that Union Grove be given an opportunity to cure the deficiencies that have been identified. In this case, Commission Staff proposed until August 28, 2017, for Union Grove to cure the deficiencies and requests that Commission Staff be given until October 6, 2017, to file a supplemental recommendation on this application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Union Grove's application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. Applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made;¹ therefore, at this time, this application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before **August 28, 2017**, Union Grove shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until

the requested items are received and reviewed. On or before **October 6, 2017**, Commission Staff shall file another supplemental recommendation on this application.
