**FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,  
ADDRESSING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's September 29, 2017 recommendations in this application, regarding administrative completeness, notice, and a procedural schedule for continued processing. Commission Staff recommended that the application, following supplementation, be found administratively complete and that Union Grove Water Supply Corporation be required to provide notice consistent with the memorandum of Jolie Mathis of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that Union Grove provide notice and be required to submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued, within 30 days of the date of notice and last publication date. Commission Staff also proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of this application.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, this application is sufficient and administratively complete. Union Grove shall provide notice of this application consistent with Commission Staff's September 29, 2017, recommendation and use the forms provided in the recommendation. Commission Staff's proposed procedural schedule is adopted as follows:

Commission Staff files comments on proof of notice and additional procedural schedule	November 17, 2017
