COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY OF NOTICE

Comes now the Staff ("Staff") of the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission"), representing the public interest, and files its Recommendation on Sufficiency of Notice. In support thereof, Staff would show the following:

I. Background

On May 23, 2017, Union Grove Water Supply Corporation ("Union Grove" or "Applicant") filed an application ("Application") to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 10514 in Upshur County. Union Grove seeks to add three new areas of service that total approximately 2,212 acres and include 35 current customers. Union Grove seeks to be dually-certificated with the City of East Mountain (the "City") in a portion of the new service area.

On October 3, 2017, the Administrative Law Judge (the "ALJ") issued Order No. 4 deeming the Application sufficient for filing and requiring the issuance of notice. The Applicant filed notice documents on October 30, 2017. Order No. 4 instructed Staff to file a sufficiency of notice recommendation by November 17, 2017.

II. Staff's Recommendation

Staff has reviewed Union Grove's filed notice documents and recommends that notice is sufficient.

III. Proposed Procedural Schedule

Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

Staff's recommendation on final disposition.	January 4, 2018
Applicant's response to Staff's recommendation on final disposition. If no response is filed, the parties shall file a joint proposed notice of approval.	January 12, 2018

IV. Conclusion


Staff respectfully requests issuance of an order consistent with the above recommendations.


