ORDER NO. 2 DEEMING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND GRANTING INTERVENTION

This Order addresses Commission Staff's June 22, 2017, recommendation that the petition of Parker Area Investments, LLC is administratively complete and sufficient for further review. Commission Staff suggested and the applicant agreed that this docket should be processed under the new rules for streamlined expedited releases.¹

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the new rules for streamlined expedited releases shall apply. Under the new rules, a final order in this docket must identify what property, if any, is useless or valueless property.²

The petition is deemed administratively complete. The following procedural schedule shall apply:
