ORDER NO. 4 APPLICATION REMAINS DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's October 20, 2017 recommendation on administrative completeness of the City of Austin's application. Commission Staff finds that the City of Austin's application remains deficient for the reasons specified in the pleading and the attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes Tamayo of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that the City of Austin be given an opportunity to cure the identified deficiencies and proposed deadlines for continued processing of the application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the City of Austin's application is deemed deficient. Applications are not considered filed with the Commission until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the City of Austin's application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before November 17, 2017, the City of Austin shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. If the deficiencies are not cured, dismissal of the application will be considered. On or before December 15, 2017, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation on the amended application.
