ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT; ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's July 5, 2017 recommendation on administrative completeness of Hickory Creek Special Utility District's application. Commission Staff recommended the application be found deficient for the reasons specified in the pleading and the memorandum of Andrew Novak and Kristy Nguyen of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that Hickory Creek be provided an opportunity to cure the deficiencies and proposed deadlines for continued processing of the application.

Applications are not considered filed with the Commission until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is found incomplete and deficient. On or before **August 4, 2017**, Hickory Creek shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **September 8, 2017**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule.
