ORDER NO. 2

FINDING THE PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES FOR OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's July 7, 2017 recommendation that the petition of 5732 Woodard Partners, Ltd. be deemed administratively incomplete because it contains material deficiencies, as specified in the pleading. Commission Staff stated that Woodard failed to include a notarized affidavit in support of the required information.¹ Commission Staff also proposed deadlines that provide Woodard an opportunity to complete the application and for Commission Staff to provide a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the petition is found administratively incomplete and deficient. Petitions are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made;² thus, at this time the petition is not considered filed with the Commission.

In addition, on or before July 21, 2017, applicants shall amend the petition to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the petition cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. On or before August 4, 2017, Commission Staff shall file additional comments regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
