COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON NOTICE

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Response to Order No. 6 and Recommendation on Notice. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On June 7, 2017, RPM Water Supply Corporation (RPM WSC) filed an application to amend water certificate of convenience and necessity number 10787 in Van Zandt County. The total new service area being requested includes approximately 22 acres and 11 current customers. Order No. 3, issued August 28, 2017, required Staff to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice within 10 working days of RPM WSC providing proof of notice. RPM WSC filed its proof of notice on October 10 and 11, 2017. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

II. RECOMMENDATION ON NOTICE

Staff has reviewed RPM WSC's affidavits of notice filed on October 10 & 11, 2017 and recommend they be found sufficient. Notice was mailed on September 14, 2017 and notice was published in a newspaper for two consecutive weeks on September 17, 2017 and September 24, 2017.

III. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff recommends the notice be found sufficient. Staff therefore proposes the following procedural schedule:

Notice completed	September 24, 2017
Deadline for intervention	October 24, 2017

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Deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to Applicant for review and consent	January 24, 2017
Deadline for Applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	February 7, 2017
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the Application	February 21, 2017
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	February 28, 2017

IV. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above recommendations.


