DEEMING APPLICATION DEFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's July 7, 2017, recommendation that RPM Water Supply Corporation's application be found deficient for the reasons specified in the pleading and the attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes Tamayo of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff also recommended that RPM WSC be given an opportunity to cure the identified deficiencies and proposed deadlines for continued processing of the application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, RPM WSC's application is deemed deficient. Applications are not considered filed with the Commission until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time RPM WSC's application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before **July 24, 2017**, RPM WSC shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. On or before **August 23, 2017**, Commission Staff shall submit a supplemental recommendation on the amended application.
