AGREED MOTION TO DISMISS

TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE:

West Wise Special Utility District ("West Wise") and Sharon Boyette ("Boyette"), (collectively, the "Parties") file this Agreed Motion to Dismiss, as the Parties have reached a settlement. The Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("PUC") does not oppose this dismissal. West Wise, Boyette and the PUC are the only named parties in this docket.

I. Introduction

All parties in this docket participated in a mediation on October 18, 2017 which resulted in execution of a Mediated Settlement Agreement ("Settlement"). Consistent with the Settlement West Wise filed an Agreed Motion to Abate the procedural schedule to allow the West Wise Board of Directors ("Board") to schedule and hold a meeting to act on the Settlement. The Motion was granted in SOAH Order No. 5. On October 25, 2017, the Board approved the Settlement. Therefore, consistent with the Settlement, the Parties request that the Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") dismiss this docket in its entirety.

II. Request to Dismiss

In the Settlement, the Parties stipulated that not later than five days after the Board approved the proposed settlement, the Parties would file an agreed motion to dismiss in which



Boyette would withdraw the appeal forming the basis of this proceeding. Accordingly, by this motion Boyette withdraws the appeal and the Parties request the matter be dismissed in its entirety.

III. Conclusion

WHEREFORE PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Parties request that the ALJ grant this Agreed Motion to Dismiss and issue an order dismissing this matter in its entirety.
