House Hahl Commercial Owners Association, Inc. has filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to obtain a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide sewer utility service in Harris County.

The requested area is located approximately 25 miles northwest of downtown Houston, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Trinity Trail, on the east by House Hahl Road, on the south by House Hahl Road, and on the west by a line 950 feet west of and parallel to House Hahl Road.

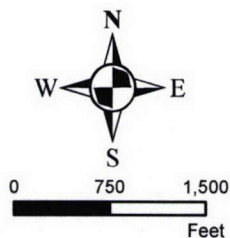
