**ORDER NO. 1
REQUIRING RESPONSES**

I. Background

On July 5, 2017, Everett Stratton filed a complaint against Westwood Water Supply Corporation regarding a change in water service provider, water services/facilities, and associated fees and deposits. This complaint is filed under 16 TAC § 22.242 and is available on the Public Utility Commission of Texas' Interchange.¹

II. Requiring Response

In accordance with 16 TAC § 22.78, Westwood shall file a response to the complaint no later than **July 26, 2017**, addressing the following:

1. the Commission's jurisdiction over this proceeding;
2. allegations raised in the complaint;
3. applicable statutes, rules, orders and/or tariff provisions;
4. copies of any rates/tariffs that are the subject of this complaint; and
5. any other matters relevant to the complaint.

III. Statement of Position from Commission Staff

Commission Staff shall file a statement of position by **August 2, 2017**. As part of the statement of position, Commission Staff shall address whether Mr. Stratton complied with the requirements for informal resolution under 16 TAC § 22.242.

IV. Filings

To ensure the efficient processing of this proceeding, all pleadings and other filings shall be deemed filed when the proper number of copies are presented to the PUC Filing Clerk for filing

V. Ex Parte Communications


