COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Recommendation on Administrative Completeness. In support thereof, Staff would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On July 5, 2017, Plan Z, LLC (Plan Z) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to cancel its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 13080 in Travis County. After a planned subdivision never came to fruition, Plan Z never provided water service and was dissolved as a company in 2010.

On July 11, 2017, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 1, requiring staff to file a recommendation on administrative completeness by August 4, 2017. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

II. RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

As detailed in the attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes Tamayo of the Water Utilities Division, Staff reviewed the materials submitted by Plan Z and recommends that the application be deemed sufficient for filing and be found administratively complete.

III. NOTICE REQUIREMENTS

Staff has attached the notice the Applicants must provide to any districts, utilities, and cities within two miles of the proposed service area, the county judges of Travis County, each groundwater conservation district and city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction that is wholly or

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partly included in the proposed area to be canceled. Staff further recommends that Applicants notify the entities identified in the attached memorandum.

Further, Staff has attached the affidavit the Applicants must sign and file with the Commission after providing notice in accordance with 16 TAC § 24.112(c). Additionally, the Applicants should provide an accurate map delineating the proposed area with each mailed notice. Staff recommends that Applicants publish notice once each week for two consecutive weeks in newspapers of general circulation in Travis County.

At this time, Staff recommends that the Applicants be allowed to proceed with providing notice for the proposed transaction and be given until June 29, 2017 to provide proof of notice to the Commission.

It is recommended that the Applicant use the attached notice and affidavits to meet these requirements.

IV. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff recommends the application be found administratively complete. Staff therefore proposes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	September 25, 2017
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued

V. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ issue an order consistent with the above recommendation.

On July 11, 2017, Plan Z, LLC (Applicant) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application requesting to cancel Plan Z, LLC's water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 13080 in Travis County, Texas. The application is being reviewed under Texas Water Code §13.254(d) (TWC) and Title 16 Tex. Admin. Code §§24.115 and 24.102(a)(1) (TAC).

Background

Cooper Alliance of Texas, Ltd. (dissolved in 2011) and Landmark Residential Holdings, Ltd. both owned by Steve Klein (AKA "They" in this memo) purchased 79.12 acres in Travis County, Texas at the corner of State highway 71 and Ross Road in 2005. At that time, Garfield Water Supply Corporation (Garfield) was to provide water service to the rural area. A 250 residential lot subdivision was designed; however, Garfield did not have the capacity for 250 additional home sites and Plan Z, LLC was created to provide water service. The subdivision was never built and the raw land was sold in 2010. Plan Z, LLC as a company was dissolved in 2010.

Staff has reviewed the information provided and recommends that the application be deemed administratively complete and sufficient for filing. Staff recommends the Applicant be directed to do the following.

- 1) Provide notice of the application to the following:
 - a) any districts, utilities, and cities within two (2) miles of the proposed area;
 - b) the county judge of each county and each groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partly included in the proposed area to be Canceled;
 - c) each city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) that is wholly or partly included in the proposed area to be Canceled;
 - d) publish notice once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Travis County.

- 2) Provide notice of the application to the following entities:
 - City of Austin (CCN No. 11322)
 - Garfield WSC (CCN No. 11244)
 - Hornsby Bend Utility Co (CCN No. 11978)
 - Moores Crossing MUD
 - Southeast Travis County MUD 2
 - Travis County Judge

The Applicant must include a map showing the CCN area with the individual notices to neighboring utilities and other affected parties. Information related to districts including addresses can be obtained from the TCEQ's web site located at http://www14.tceq.texas.gov/iwud/.

Lastly, the Applicant should file within 30 days of the Commission order, a copy of the actual notice and map issued, along with signed affidavits indicating that the notice was given. It is recommended that the Applicant use the attached notices and affidavits to meet these requirements.

<u>Plan Z, LLC</u> filed a petition with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) to cease operations, discontinue providing sewer utility service, and to cancel Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 13080 in Travis County, Texas.

The proposed effective date of the action is upon approval by the PUC.

The requested area to be cancelled is located approximately <u>10</u> miles <u>east southeast</u> of downtown <u>Austin</u>, Texas, and is <u>generally</u> bounded on the north by <u>US 71</u>; on the east by <u>Ross Rd</u>; on the south by <u>Saint Thomas Dr</u>.; and on the west by <u>Saint Thomas Dr</u>.

There are no customers and no facilities in the requested area.
