**DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
ADDRESSING NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation on administrative completeness of the application. Commission Staff recommended the application be deemed administratively complete and that the applicants be required to provide notice consistent with the memorandum of Janie Kohl of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that notice be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Medina County. Commission Staff also proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of this application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, this application is deemed sufficient and administratively complete. The applicant shall provide notice of this application consistent with Commission Staff's September 28, 2017 recommendation. The procedural schedule proposed by Commission Staff is adopted, as follows:

Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	October 26, 2017
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
