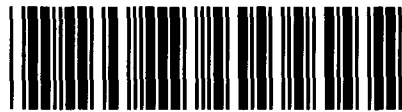


**ORDER NO. 4  
FINDING NOTICE DEFICIENT,  
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's October 26, 2017 recommendation that the notice of this application provided by Forest Glen Utility Company was deficient, for the reasons specified in the pleading and the attached memorandum of Janie Kohl, Jolie Mathis and Kristy Nguyen of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that Forest Glen reissue the notice to include a map.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Forest Glen's notice is deemed deficient. Forest Glen shall reissue notice to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. On or before **November 17, 2017**, Forest Glen shall file with the Commission signed affidavits that amended notice was given along with a copy of the notice provided. Commission Staff shall submit a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of notice within 10 days of Forest Glen filing proof of completed notice with the Commission.
