ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION DEFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's August 9, 2017, recommendation on administrative completeness of Forest Glen Utility Company's application. Commission Staff recommended the application be found deficient for the reasons specified in the pleading and the attached memorandum of Janie Kohl of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that the Forest Glen be provided an opportunity to cure the deficiencies and proposed deadlines for continued processing of the application.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation Forest Glen's application is found to be deficient. Applications are not considered filed with the Commission until a determination of administrative completeness is made;¹ thus, at this time the Forest Glen's application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before August 30, 2017, the Forest Glen shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before September 28, 2017, Commission Staff shall submit a supplemental recommendation on the amended application.
