JOINT MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE AND PROPOSED ORDER

COMES NOW the City of Horseshoe Bay (the "City") together with the Staff ("Staff") of the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission"), representing the public interest, (collectively, the Parties), and file this Joint Motion to Admit Evidence and Proposed Order. In support thereof, the Parties show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On July 12, 2017, On July 12, 2017, Horseshoe Bay Water Utility (Horseshoe Bay) filed an application to obtain new water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity in Llano County and Burnet County. On July 28, 2017, the Commission issued notice of the City's application. Order No. 11, issued on October 9, 2018, a procedural schedule including the requirement that the parties file joint findings of fact and conclusions of law. No hearing has been requested.

II. JOINT MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE

The City moves to admit the following into the record evidence in this proceeding:

- 7. City's Proof of Notice, filed on April 18, 2018;
- 8. City's Amended Proof of Notice, filed April 23, 2018;
- 9. City's Submission of Revised Sewer CCN Map, filed on July 25, 2018;
- 10. The consent form to the final map and certificates, filed on September 7, 2018;
- 11. Commission Staff recommendation that the Application be approved, along with the attached final map and certificates, filed September 14, 2018; and
 - 12. Commission Staff's proof of notice filed October 30, 2018.

III. JOINT PROPOSED ORDER

The Parties move for adoption of the attached Joint Proposed Order, which would approve the Application to grant the City water CCN No. 13271 and sewer CCN No. 2111 in Burnet and Llano Counties. The Joint Proposed Order would also cancel Deerhaven Inc.'s water CCN No. 10467.

IV. CONCLUSION

The Parties respectfully request that the Commission grant the Motion to Admit Evidence and adopt the attached Joint Proposed Order.

ORDER

This Order addresses the application of The City of Horseshoe Bay (the "City") to receive its sewer certificate of convenience and necessity ("CCN") in Llano and Burnet Counties. The Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission") Staff recommended approval of this application. The application, as amended, is approved.

The Commission adopts the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT

Procedural History and Background

- 1. On July 12, 2017, the City filed with an Application to for a new water and sewer CCNs in Llano and Burnet Counties.
- 2. On December 22, 2017, the City Amended its application to include a petition to cancel the CCN No. 10467 held by Deerhaven Inc.
- 3. Deerhaven Inc. has forfeited its status as a Texas corporation and is incapable of providing continuous and adequate service.
- 4. On June 6, 2018, the City filed supplemental information to cure the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff.
- 5. On June 22, 2018, Order No. 8 was issued, deeming the application, as amended, administratively complete, addressing notice and establishing procedural schedule.
- 6. On August 8, 2018, Commission Staff recommended approval of the application, and provided copies of the City's final sewer map and CCN certificate, which were consented to on August 10, 2018 and filed with the Commission on August 10, 2018.
- 7. The final map and the updated sewer CCN No. 21111 are attached to this Notice.

Notice

- 10. On March 6, 2018m Commission Staff mailed notice to Deerhaven, Inc. of its pending decertification by certified mail, return receipt requested to Deerhaven, Inc.'s last know address. Additionally, Staff mailed notice by certified mail, return receipt requested, to Deerhaven, Inc.'s last listed registered Agent Wade Hutto.
- 11. On June 7, 2018 the City mailed notice of the application to neighboring utilities, landowners, and affected parties.
- 12. On March 30, 2018 and April 5, 2018, notice was published in The Horseshoe Bay Beacon, a newspaper of general circulation in Llano and Burnet Counties.
- 13. On August 14, 2018, the City filed affidavits of notice attesting to mailed notice and on April 24, 2018 the City filed affidavits of notice attesting to published notice.

Informal Disposition

- 14. The only parties to this proceeding are the City and Commission Staff.
- 15. More than 15 days has passed since completion of the notice provided in this docket.
- 16. No protest, request for hearing, or opt-out requests were filed in this docket, therefore, no hearing is necessary.

The requirements for informal disposition pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 22.35 (TAC) have been met in this proceeding.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Commission has jurisdiction and authority over this docket pursuant to Tex. Water Code §§ 13.041 and 13.241 (TWC).
- 2. The City is a municipality as defined in TWC § 13.002(12) and 16 TAC § 24.3(42).
- 3. Public notice of the application was provided in compliance with TWC § 13.246 and 16 TAC § 24.235.
- 4. Notice to Deerhaven, Inc. of its pending decertification was provided in compliance with 16 TAC § 22.183.

- 5. The application meets the requirements set forth in TWC §§ 13.241, 13.244 and 13.246, and 16 TAC §§ 24.225-24.227 and 24.231-24.235.
- 6. After considering the factors in TWC § 13.246(c), the City is entitled to approval of the application, having demonstrated adequate financial, managerial and technical capability for providing continuous and adequate sewer service to the requested area and its existing service area, as required by TWC § 13.241(a).
- 7. Approval of this application is necessary for the service, accommodation, convenience, and safety of the public as required by TWC § 13.246(b) and 16 TAC § 24.227(c).
- 8. Under TWC §13.257(r) and 16 TAC § 24.235(f), the City is required to record a certified copy of the approved sewer CCN and map, along with a boundary description of the service area in the real property records of each county in which the service area or a portion of the service area is located, and submit to the Commission evidence of the recording.
- 9. The requirements for informal disposition pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.35 have been met in this proceeding.


III.ORDERING PARAGRAPHS LAW

In accordance with these findings of fact and conclusions of law, the Commission issues the following Order.

- 1. The application of the City of Horseshoe Bay is approved:
- 2. The City of Horseshoe Bay's sewer CCN No. 21111 is consistent with this Notice.
- 3. The City of Horseshoe Bay shall serve every customer and applicant for sewer service within the area certified under CCN No. 21111, and such service shall be continuous and adequate.
- 4. The City of Horseshoe Bay shall comply with the recording requirements in TWC § 13.257(r) for the area in Llano and Burnet Counties affected by this application and submit to the Commission evidence of the recording no later than 31 days after receipt of this Notice.

	and any other requests for general or specific relief, if not expressly	granted in this		
	Notice, are denied.






