NOTICE OF APPROVAL

This Notice addresses the application of Mustang Special Utility District to amend certificates of convenience and necessity (CCNs) in Denton and Collin Counties. Commission Staff recommended approval of the application. The Commission approves the application, as supplemented.

The Commission adopts the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

I. Findings of Fact

Procedural History

- On July 28, 2017, Mustang SUD filed an application to amend water CCN No. 11856 and 1. sewer CCN No. 20930 in Denton and Collin Counties.
- The total proposed service area consists of approximately 1,460 acres for water and 446 acres 2. for sewer. There are currently no existing customers.
- On August 1, 2017, Order No. 1 was issued requiring Commission Staff's comments on 3. administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice.
- On August 29, 2017, Order No. 2 was filed finding Mustang SUD's application deficient. 4. establishing deadlines and an opportunity to cure.
- On October 13, 2017, Mustang SUD filed amended maps and TCEQ approval letters for the 5. appropriate water facilities to cure deficiencies listed in Commission Staff's recommendation.
- 6. On November 3, 2017, Order No. 3 was issued finding that the application was administratively complete and requiring Mustang SUD to provide notice consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation.

- 7. On December 12, 2017, Order No. 4 was issued finding the notice provided by Mustang SUD sufficient.
- 8. On February 21, 2018, Mustang SUD filed a signed consent form concurring with the proposed maps and certificates as prepared by Commission Staff.
- 9. The maps and certificates referenced above are attached to this Notice.
- 10 On March 9, 2018, Commission Staff recommended approval of the application.
- 11. On March 16, 2018. Commission Staff filed a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed notice of approval

Notice

- 12 Oa August 11, 2017, notice of the application was published in the Texas Register.
- On November 21, 2017, Mustang SUD filed an affidavit affirming that mailed notice of the application to current customers, neighboring systems, cities and other affected parties was completed on November 10, 2017.
- Oa November 21, 2017, Mustang SUD filed publisher's affidavits affirming that notice was provided by publication in the *Celma Record* and the *Denton Record-Chronicle* on November 10, 2017 and November 17, 2017.

Evidentiary Record

15. On March 23, 2018, Order No. 5 was issued admitting evidence into the record.

Informal Disposition

- 16. More than 15 days have passed since the completion of the notice provided in this docket.
- 17. Mustang SUD and Commission Staff are the only parties to this proceeding.
- 18. No issues of fact or law remain disputed by any party.
- 19. No protests or requests for hearing were filed

The Application

- 20. There is no service currently being provided to the requested area.
- 21. Mustang SUD currently has no customers. Service in the requested area is needed as CADG

- Aubrey 107, LLC and Pulte Homes of Texas, L.P. have requested water and sewer service through a nonstandard service agreement for the Winn Ridge property.
- 22. Granting Mustang SUD's CCN amendments will not adversely affect any landowners in the area or any retail public utility serving the proximate area. Through a settlement agreement, Mustang SUD, the City of Aubrey and the developers agreed that Mustang SUD shall be the sole provider of the Winn Ridge water and sewer service areas.
- 23. Mustang SUD has the ability to provide adequate service to the requested area through the capacity of its public water system and sewer treatment facilities, approved by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
- 24. It is not feasible for an adjacent retail public utility to provide service to the requested area. Through a settlement agreement, Mustang SUD, the City of Aubrey and the developers agreed that Mustang SUD shall be the sole water and sewer service provider of the Winn Ridge property which was decertified from Mustang SUD through expedited release in Docket Nos. 44581¹ and 44580.²
- 25 Mustang SUD has demonstrated that it has the financial resources to operate and manage the utility and the ability to provide continuous and adequate service to the requested area.
- 26. The environmental integrity and the effect on the land to be included in the certificate will be minimally affected as the requested area is developed.
- 27. Granting the CCN amendment will allow the landowners to obtain water and sewer service from Mustang SUD for future area development.

II. Conclusions of Law

1. Mustang SUD is a retail public utility as defined in TWC § 13.002(19)³ and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.3(59).

- 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over the application under TWC §§ 13.041, 13.241, and 13.246
- 3. Public notice of the application was provided in compliance with TWC § 13.246 and 16 TAC § 24.106.
- 4. The application was processed in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act. TWC and Commission rules.
- 5. After considering the factors in TWC § 13.246(c). Mustang SUD is entitled to approval of their water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity, having demonstrated adequate financial, managerial and technical capability for providing continuous and adequate service to the requested area and its current service area as required by TWC § 13.241.
- 6. Approval of the application is necessary for the service, accommodation, convenience, or safety of the public as required by TWC \$ 13.246(b) and 16 TAC § 24.102(c).
- 7. Under TWC § 13.257(r) and (s). Mustang SUD is required to record a certified copy of the approved CCN and map, along with a boundary description of the service area in the real property records of each county in which the service area or a portion of the service area is located, and submit to the Commission evidence of the recording
- The requirements for informal disposition in 16 TAC § 22.35 have been met in this proceeding.

III. Ordering Paragraphs

In accordance with these findings of fact and conclusions of law, the Commission issues the following orders:

- 1. The Commission approves the application, as supplemented
- 2. Mustang SUD's water CCN No. 11856 and sewer CCN No. 20930 are amended, consistent with this Notice.

- 3. The Commission's official service area boundary maps for Aubrey and Mustang SUD shall reflect this change as shown in the attached maps.
- 4. Mustang SUD shall serve every customer and applicant for service within the areas certified under its CCNs, and such service shall be continuous and adequate.
- 5. Mustang SUD shall comply with the recording requirements in TWC § 13.257(r) and (s) for the area in Denton and Collin Counties affected by the application and submit to the Commission evidence of the recording no later than 31 days after receipt of this Notice.
- 6. All other motions and any other requests for general or specific relief, if not expressly granted, are denied.


