**ORDER NO. 2  
FINDING APPLICATION DEFICIENT,  
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's August 28, 2017, recommendation regarding administrative completeness of Mustang Special Utility District's application. Commission Staff recommended the application be found deficient for the reasons specified in the pleading and the attached memorandum of Jolie Mathis of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that Mustang SUD be provided an opportunity to cure the deficiencies and proposed deadlines for continued processing of the application.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation Mustang SUD's application is administratively incomplete. Applications are not considered filed with the Commission until a determination of administrative completeness is made;<sup>1</sup> thus, at this time the Mustang SUD's application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before **October 13, 2017**, Mustang SUD shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **October 28, 2017**, Commission Staff shall submit a supplemental recommendation on the amended application.
