ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL AND DISMISSING COMPLAINT

This Order addresses the formal complaint filed by Clay Morehead against Corey Abel, trustee to the Castlecomb Trust. On November 3, 2020, Mr. Morehead filed a request to withdraw the complaint. The Commission grants Mr. Morehead's request to withdraw the complaint and dismisses the complaint without prejudice.

In his formal complaint, Mr. Morehead asserted that the Castlecomb Trust, owner of the Castlecomb utility, was providing water and sewer service without a certificate of convenience and necessity. On September 12, 2019, the Commission administrative law judge (ALJ) filed a proposal for decision (PFD) in this docket. The Commission considered the PFD at the October 11, 2019 open meeting and determined that there was insufficient information in the record to act on the PFD. Accordingly, the Commission took no action on the PFD at the meeting.


On September 30, 2020, the Commission appointed CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC as temporary manager of the Castlecomb utility for an indefinite term. On November 3, 2020, Mr. Morehead filed a request to withdraw his complaint. A request to withdraw a complaint with or without prejudice after a PFD has been filed may be granted only upon a finding of good cause by the Commission.¹ The Commission finds good cause exists to grant Mr. Morehead's request to withdraw his complaint, without prejudice.

The Commission grants Clay Morehead's request to withdraw his complaint in this proceeding. The Commission dismisses the complaint without prejudice under 16 TAC § 22.181(d)(10).


