ORDER NO. 5 DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, ADDRESSING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's January 23, 2018, recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application. Commission Staff recommended the application be deemed administratively complete and that the applicant be required to provide notice consistent with the memorandum of Brannon Pennick and Heidi Graham of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that the applicant be required to submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued, within 30 days of the date of notice and last publication date. Commission Staff also proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of this application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, this application is deemed sufficient and administratively complete. The applicant shall provide notice of this application consistent with Commission Staff's January 23, 2018, recommendation and use the forms provided in the recommendation. Commission Staff's proposed procedural schedule is adopted as follows:

Deadline for the applicant to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	March 9, 2018
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of the applicant filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
