ORDER NO. 2 DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING LIMITED NOTICE, DENYING REQUEST FOR WAIVER OF A HEARING, AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINES

This Order addresses Commission Staff's September 7, 2017 recommendation on administrative completeness of the application and requested waivers, as explained in the pleading and the attached memorandum of Leila Guerrero in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that the application be deemed sufficient for filing and be found administratively complete. However, Commission Staff does not support Undine Texas, LLC's request for waiver of notice and did not recommend waiving a hearing. Commission Staff recommended limited notice and opted not to propose a procedural schedule until a ruling on notice has been issued.

Consistent with Staff's recommendation, the application is deemed administratively complete. Further, Undine's request for waiver of a hearing is denied and Undine's request for waiver of notice is denied in part; notice to entities, as described in 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.109(d), is waived.

Undine shall provide mailed notice and proof of notice no later than the deadline established below consistent with the instructions and using the forms provided by Commission Staff. Additionally, instead of allowing a 30-day notice period from the date of service to intervene, the notice should allow a 20-day period.

The following deadlines shall apply:

Deadline for Undine to file proof of notice	September 21, 2017
Deadline to intervene and deadline for intervenors to request a hearing	20 days from the date of notice
Commission Staff shall file a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice and include a procedural schedule	20 days from proof of notice
