**ORDER NO. 6
APPROVING TRANSACTION TO PROCEED**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's November 29, 2017 recommendation that the applicants be allowed to proceed with this transaction and that the applicants provide the final sale documents so that final mapping can be completed.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the transaction between Undine Texas LLC and Consumers Water, Inc. may proceed and be consummated. As soon as possible after the effective date of the transaction, but not later than 30 days after the effective date, the applicants shall file proof that the transaction has been consummated and customer deposits addressed. The applicants have 180 days to complete the transaction. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.109(o), if the transaction is not consummated within this period, or an extension granted, this approval is void and the applicants will have to reapply for approval. The applicants are advised that certificate of convenience and necessity number 10347 will continue to be held by Consumers Water until the sale and transfer transaction is complete in accordance with the Commission's rules.

In an effort to finalize this case as soon as possible, beginning January 15, 2018 and continuing monthly thereafter, the applicants shall file an update regarding the status of the efforts to conclude the transaction and submit documents evidencing that the transaction was consummated.

Within 15 days following the filing of the applicants' proof that the transaction has been consummated and customer deposits (if any) have been addressed, Commission Staff shall file a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the documents and propose a schedule for the continued processing of this docket.
