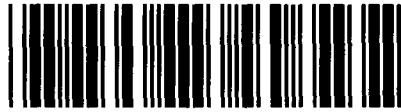

**DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
 ADDRESSING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**


This Order addresses Commission Staff's September 11 2017, recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application. Commission Staff recommended the application be deemed administratively complete and that the applicant be required to provide notice consistent with the memorandum of Leila Guerrero of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the forms attached to the memorandum. Commission Staff recommended that the applicant be required to submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, including publisher's affidavits, along with a copy of the actual notices issued. Commission Staff proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of the application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, this application is deemed sufficient and administratively complete. Aqua Utilities, Inc. d/b/a Aqua Texas shall provide notice of this application consistent with Commission Staff's September 11, 2017, recommendation and use the forms provided in the recommendation. Commission Staff's proposed procedural schedule is adopted as follows:

Event	Date
Deadline for the applicant to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	October 26, 2017
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of the applicant filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
