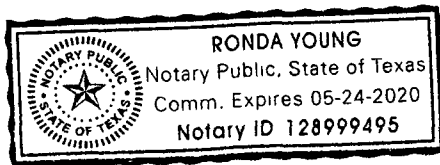

NOTICE OF APPLICATION OF AQUA UTILITIES, INC. DBA AQUA TEXAS TO AMEND A SEWER CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY (CCN) IN HAYS COUNTY, TEXAS

Aqua Utilities, Inc. d/b/a Aqua Texas (Applicant) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to amend sewer CCN No. 20453 in Hays County, Texas.

The proposed utility service area is located approximately 6 miles northeast of downtown San Marcos, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by CR 158; on the east by RM 150; on the south by Yarrington Rd and SH 21; and on the west by Yarrington Rd and CR 158.

A copy of the proposed service area map may be viewed at: Aqua Utilities, Inc., 1106 Clayton Lane, Suite 400W, Austin, Texas 78723, (512) 990-4400.

The total requested sewer service area includes approximately 524 acres of land and 0 current customers.

You may request a public hearing. A request for a public hearing must be in writing and include: (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the Applicant's name, docket number or another recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement of why you request a public hearing; (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

Hearing requests, comments or requests to intervene should be filed with the:

within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

A landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the requested area, may file a written request with the Commission to be excluded from the requested area ("opt out request") within thirty (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the applicant. All opt out requests must include a large scale map and a metes and bounds description of the landowner's tract of land.

Persons who wish to make an opt out request should file the required documents with the:

In addition, the landowner must also send a copy of the opt out request to the Applicant. Staff may request additional information regarding any opt out request.

Hearing- and speech-impaired individuals with text telephones (TTY) may contact the commission at (512) 936-7136. The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is (30) days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer. You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date.

The purpose of this notice is to groundwater withdrawal permit hold Edwards Aquifer Authority (EAA) declaring Stage I of the EAA Crit recently satisfied. The General implementation of Stage I Critical 2017.

When water levels of the Aquifer or Marcos Springs decline below certain Management Plan of the EAA is from the Aquifer. This plan is designed to protect Aquifer levels or springflows. During the implementation of the groundwater withdrawal amount controlled and adjusted downward by the calculation. For the San Antonio Pool, permitted 20% during Stage I.

In accordance with EAA rules, one San Antonio Pool may claim an exemption in order to finish irrigating a crop advantage of this exemption, an irrigation Finish Out a Crop form with the EAA notice forms are available at [www.edwardsaquifer.org](http://www.edwardsaquifer.org), or may be used to aid in calculating the groundwater withdrawal.
