ORDER NO. 2 FINDING THE PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's September 14, 2017 recommendation that the petition of landowners, Kimbro Road Estates, LP, Sky Village Kimbro Estates, LLC, Alma Juanita Champion Meier, William Clark Meier, and Carolyn Juanita Fauber, be deemed administratively incomplete because it contains material deficiencies, as specified in the memorandum of Patricia Garcia, of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff also proposed deadlines for the applicants to cure the deficiency and for Commission Staff to provide a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the petition is found administratively incomplete and deficient. Petitions are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made;¹ thus, at this time the petition is not considered filed with the Commission.

Consistent with Staff's recommendation, on or before October 16, 2017, applicants shall amend the petition to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the petition cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. On or before November 15, 2017, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
