ORDER EXTENDING THE COMMISSION'S PREVIOUS ORDER AS HER DEFERRED PAYMENT PLANS FOR ELECTRICITY CUSTOMERS

On August 31, 2017, the Commission issued an Order to Assist Implementing of the Governor's Proclamations Related to the Disaster Caused by Hurricane Harvey. As part of that Order, the Commission directed Retail Electric Providers to offer deferred payment plans to customers, pursuant to 16 TAC § 25.480(j)(1)(B).

This particular provision expires on September 29, 2017. Recognizing that many customers are still recovering from the effects of the hurricane, the Commission extends this provision and directs Retail Electric Providers to offer deferred payment plans to customers, upon request, if the service location is within an area covered by a disaster declaration until October 12, 2017.
