**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
ADDRESSING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's October 6, 2017 recommendation on administrative completeness and proposed notice. Commission Staff recommended that the application be found administratively complete and that the City of Aubrey be required to provide notice consistent with the memorandum of Greg Charles of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that the City of Aubrey provide notice and be required to submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued, within 30 days of the date of notice and last publication date. Commission Staff also proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of this application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, this application is sufficient and administratively complete. The City of Aubrey shall provide notice of this application consistent with Commission Staff's October 6, 2017, recommendation and use the forms provided in the recommendation. Commission Staff's proposed procedural schedule is adopted as follows:



Deadline for the City of Aubrey to file with the commission signed affidavits that notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	November 20, 2017

Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency	Within 10 day days of Aubrey filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued.
