Staff 2-1 Please indicate if any of Thunderbird Point Water System's capacity will be used after the transfer is approved.

Bi-County WSC'S response to Staff 2-1 submitted by Harlton Taylor and Jim Davis.

Bi-County Water Supply Corporation (BCWSC) plans to cement in the Thunderbird Point existing well within six months of closing of the acquisition. Methodology for the closing will be in compliance with any and all rules and regulations for abandonment of a well as specified by Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR Chapter 76.104). Also in accordance with applicable sections of the Texas Administrative Code, and/or requirements for public water systems by TCEQ or the PUC.

At this time BCWSC believes it would be cost ineffective to utilize the vertical water storage tank. This does not preclude at some unknown future date that BCWSC may find it advantageous to its membership to convert the vertical storage tank to another use either at its current location or elsewhere within BCWSC's CCN.

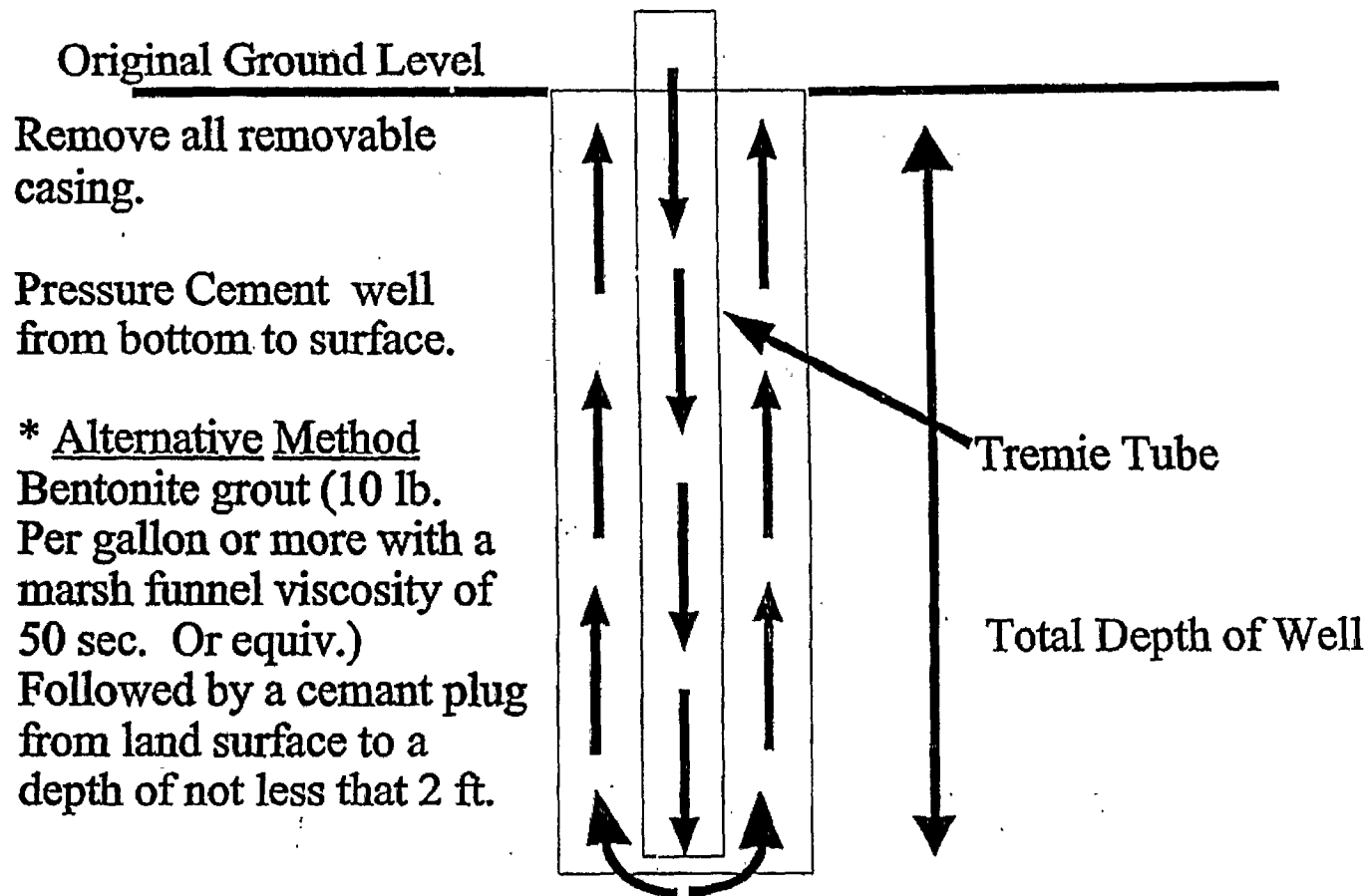

Provide proof that the violations noted by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for Bi-County WSC have been addressed.

Based on information collected by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and published on the internet in the Drinking Water Watch site, Bi-County Water Supply Corporation currently has two unresolved violations. The first violation originated in the quarterly reporting period beginning 10-01-2016 and ending 12-31-2016. Bi-County prepared and filed the Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report during the first week of January 2017 and all results were within the allowable range. The Drinking Water Watch website now displays that violation as resolved. (2016-90065299) See attached.

Based on conversations with current TCEQ staff, the agency did not log receipt of our Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report until on or about February 13, 2017. This triggered two violations: one because the report was delinquent and second because we did not send a Certificate of Delivery of Public Notice to Customers. Bi-County did not send the second form because it believed the report was logged as received by the TCEQ in a timely manner.

Now, nearly a year later, Bi-County becomes aware that the Public Notice violation remains unresolved. The following measures have been, or are scheduled to take place in the next few days, in order to bring this matter into compliance.

- 1) The required notices have been posted on our website at www.bicountwsc.com (See Attached)
- 2) On our end of December billing statement is notice mailed to all members of the required filings being posted on our website. (See Attached)
- 3) The required filings are posted in locations where we typically communicate with our membership.
- 4) To avoid a reoccurrence of this violation, Bi-County will now submit the Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report via an Electronic Reporting System.

The second violation which remains unresolved is a result of a failure to send Lead and Copper Notices to the members from whom samples were drawn in December of 2013 and 2016. This inaction has produced violation numbers 2017-90065298 and 2014-90065291. Thirty letters mailed to the affected members in each year will correct the violation. Bi-County WSC will send the required notices and proof of mailing to TCEQ on or before January 30, 2018. The test results showed all samples to be within the allowable range for lead and copper.




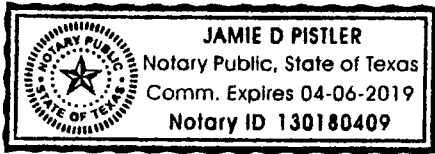


