STATUS UPDATE VIII


Pursuant to Order No. IV issued in this docket, Jennifer Fultz, Receiver for Thunderbird Point Water System (“Receiver” herein) presents this update as to the status of the transfer of the Thunderbird Point Water System (“Water System” herein) to Bi-County Water Supply Corporation (“Bi-County” herein).

1. Since the filing of the Status Update VII dated May 24, 2019, the Receiver’s actions have included the following:
 - a. On May 16, 2019, the Receiver discussed the need for clarification on Order No. 6 with the PUC attorney;
 - b. On May 25, 2019, the Receiver prepared a draft of the Request for Clarification to be filed with the PUC in this matter, a copy of which was forwarded to PUC attorney for review;
 - c. On May 30, 2019, the Receiver forwarded the final version of the Request for Clarification to Harlton Taylor of Bi-County for review;
 - d. On May 30, 2019, the Receiver prepared correspondence to PUC forwarding by mail the original Request for Clarification and ten (10) copies, appropriate parties were copied;
 - e. On or about June 5, 2019, the Assistant Attorney General (AG) contacted the Receiver to inform her that the Charles Schram was willing to sign a deed on behalf of American Central Land Corporation to avoid additional litigation;
 - f. On June 6, 2019, the Receiver forwarded drafts of the proposed Deed to the AG for review;
 - g. On June 10, 2019, the Receiver conferenced with the AG and was advised that the Owner is willing to execute the Deed upon receiving confirmation that he is the record owner;

- h. On June 11, 2019, the Receiver received Order #8 – Approving Sale/Transfer to Proceed, a copy was forwarded to all parties;
 - i. On June 14, 2019, the Receiver met at the TCEQ offices with members of TCEQ, PUC and the office of the Attorney General of Texas and discussed the status of the pending transfer to Bi-County Water Supply Corporation;
 - j. The Receiver continues to monitor and confirm Bi-County is operating the Water System in a best practices manner to provide the continuous and adequate supply of water to the customers; and,
 - k. The Receiver continues to communicate with TCEQ and the office of the Attorney General of Texas regarding securing the full legal authority to convey all assets of the Water System to Bi-County.
2. Upon closing the transaction to Bi-County Water Supply Corporation, the Receiver will provide the Commission with notice of the closing, executed closing documents, and any other required information to complete this matter; and,
3. In the interim, the Receiver shall keep the Commission informed of any significant developments.
