ORDER NO. 6
GRANTING SECOND REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF
TIME TO COMPLETE SALE TRANSACTION

This Order addresses Undine Texas Environmental, LLC's (Undine) August 20, 2018, second request to extend the time to complete the transaction with Gulf Coast Utility Company, Inc. (Gulf Coast). Undine states that additional issues regarding the assignment or transfer of certain easements previously unknown to the parties and relevant to this transaction exist, which require an additional 45 days to resolve. Undine represented that Commission Staff is not opposed to the request.


As described above, Undine has shown good cause to extend the time of closing.

The administrative law judge grants the request and extends the time for Undine and Gulf Coast to complete the transaction, under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.109(o), until October 6, 2018.¹ If the parties do not complete the transaction within this period, approval of the transaction is void.

Within 30 days following the date the parties file proof that they completed the transaction and addressed customer deposits, if any, Commission Staff shall file a recommendation on the adequacy of the documents.
