

CITY OF PORTLAND'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW REQUEST FOR HEARING

NOW COMES the CITY OF PORTLAND, TEXAS ("Portland"), an intervenor and named party in the above-cited matter, and files this Motion to Withdraw Request for Hearing ("Motion to Withdraw").

I. BACKGROUND

- 1. Rincon Water Supply Corporation ("Rincon") is a Class B investor-owned utility. On September 26, 2017, Rincon filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission") an Application to Obtain or Amend a Water or Sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Application") to amend Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") No. 114400, in San Patricio and Aransas Counties.
- 2. On December 12, 2017, the City of Taft requested a hearing on the Application. On February 26, 2018, the Commission referred this case to the State Office of Administrative Hearings ("SOAH").
- 3. On June 3, 2019, the SOAH Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") entered Order No. 7, remanding this case back to the Commission.
- 4. On September 6, 2019, Portland filed a Motion to Intervene in this case. On September 19, 2019, the Commission ALJ issued Order No. 9, finding that Portland presented a justiciable interest in this case and granting Portland's Motion to Intervene.

5. On December 17, 2019, the Commission filed an Order of Referral, referring this case back to SOAH, and, *inter alia*, authorizing Commission Staff and any other interested party

to file a list of issues to be addressed in the SOAH docket.

6. On February 5, 2020, the SOAH ALJ entered Order No. 2, Memorializing

Prehearing Conference; Adopting Procedural Schedule; Notice of Hearing.

7. Subsequently, Portland and Rincon entered into good faith negotiations to resolve

all matters at issue between Portland and Rincon.

8. This pleading services as notice to PUC Staff, the SOAH ALJ, and the Commission

that, on August 20, 2020, Portland and Rincon reached terms of settlement, and each of their

governing bodies considered, approved, and provided for the execution of a Settlement Agreement,

therein disposing of all matters at issue between the two parties.

9. For the above-stated reasons and pursuant to Portland's commitment under the

Settlement Agreement, Portland respectfully withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

Portland further requests that the SOAH ALJ remand this matter back to the Commission for final

disposition and such other actions as the Commission deems appropriate.
