JOINT REQUEST TO CONSIDER JOINT PROPOSED ORDER

COMES NOW the Mustang Special Utility District (Mustang SUD) and Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) (collectively, the Parties), and files this Joint Request to Consider Joint Proposed Order. In support thereof, the Parties would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On September 28, 2017, Mustang SUD filed a notice of intent to provide retail water service to an approximately 102-acre area decertified from Terra Southwest's CCN No. 11608 in Denton County in TCEQ Application No. 37386-C. That notice of intent indicated that there was an agreement (Settlement Agreement) between Mustang SUD and Terra Southwest regarding compensation to be paid to Terra Southwest.

On October 2, 2017, the Commission issued Order No. 1, which requested the parties propose a procedural schedule to allow for the Settlement Agreement to be presented to the Commission at an open meeting. On October 9, 2017, the Commission issued Order No. 2, which adopted a procedural schedule. On October 19, 2017, the Commission Staff filed its recommendation on final disposition, in which the Staff recommended that the Settlement Agreement be presented to the Commission at an open meeting for consideration and action. On October 30, 2017, Mustang SUD filed a proposed order.

II. REQUEST TO CONSIDER REVISED JOINT PROPOSED ORDER

Because of a miscommunication among the Parties, a proposed order was filed solely from Mustang SUD. The parties have subsequently agreed on the attached Joint Proposed Order.
