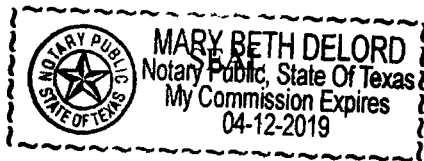

**NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE

APPLICATION.

Bolivar Utility Services, LLC has filed an application with the Public Utility Commission (PUC) to amend its tariff and change its rates for sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 21026 in Galveston County. The proposed increase had an effective date of December 1, 2017, which has been suspended by the PUC until October 14, 2018.

CONTESTED CASE HEARING.

A prehearing conference will be convened at **10:00 a.m., on February 21, 2018, at the State Office of Administrative Hearings, 300 West 15th Street, 4th Floor, Austin, Texas.** Matters that may be discussed include procedures, pending motions, possible settlement of issues, the procedural schedule (including the hearing date), and other matters that may aid in efficient and fair processing of this case. Persons who attend the prehearing conference must first check in with building security personnel in the building's lobby and be issued visitor badges, and should allow sufficient time for the check-in procedure.

Any person who wants to intervene in this case (i.e., participate in this case as a party) shall move to intervene either (1) in a written motion to intervene **filed at the Commission no later than February 16, 2018;** or (2) **orally at the February 21, 2018 preheating conference.** Any filed motion shall refer to SOA.H Docket No. 473-18-1906.WS and PUC Docket No. 47680, include the person's contact information, and otherwise comply with the Commission's procedural rules. Previous submission of a protest does not meet the requirement that a person who wants to participate as a party must move to intervene as described above.
