



I. SUPPLEMENTAL ANSWERS TO COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO BOLIVAR UTILITY SERVICES, LLC (BOLVIAR)

QUESTION NOS. STAFF 1-1

Staff 1-1: Provide a detailed, written explanation of how Bolivar actually measures wastewater usage and any documentation, like the monthly billing register for each customer, supporting this explanation

RESPONSE: Wastewater volume is based upon the amount of water purchased from the third-party water purveyor, the Bolivar Peninsula Special Utility District. The third-party water purveyor handles the billing for Bolivar Utility Service, and it includes our bill on it's bill as part of a cooperative billing arrangement. A copy of a report of annual customer volumetric usage prepared by the Bolivar Peninsula Special Utility District is filed as Confidential Information in accordance with 16 TAC § 22.71(d).
