**ORDER NO. 1  
REQUIRING COMMISSION STAFF COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATION**

**I. Application**

This Order addresses the October 12, 2017 application of George T. Foley/Aileen M. Foley Estate for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Bosque County. Specifically, the Foley Estate seeks approval to sell and transfer all of water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11777 to Crystal Clear Water, Inc.'s CCN No. 12997.

**II. Establishing Deadline for Commission Staff's Recommendation**

Commission Staff shall file, on or before **November 13, 2017**, comments/recommendation regarding administrative completeness of this application,<sup>1</sup> whether additional notice may be required to comply with the applicable procedural rules, and propose a schedule for processing.

**III. Filings**

Unless otherwise specified, an original and ten copies of documents relating to this proceeding must be filed with the Commission filing clerk.<sup>2</sup> A copy of each document filed with

the Commission must also be served on all parties.<sup>3</sup> Filings can be accessed on the PUC Interchange, <http://interchange.puc.texas.gov>.

All parties shall provide their current addresses, telephone and facsimile numbers, if available, to all other parties and the Commission by filing and serving all parties with such information. Each party shall provide the Commission and all parties with updated address, telephone, and facsimile information if such information changes. The telephone and facsimile numbers will be placed on the service list for this proceeding. Parties are responsible for updating their own service lists to reflect changed information and the addition of any other parties.

#### IV. Protective Order

The Commission's Standard Protective Order attached to this Order is adopted for use in this proceeding and shall remain in effect unless ordered otherwise.

#### V. Ex Parte Communications

*Ex parte* communications with the administrative law judges and presiding officer (collectively, ALJs) are prohibited.<sup>4</sup> Parties shall communicate with the ALJs only through written documents filed with the Commission's Filing Clerk and served on all parties. Questions concerning this order or any other order must be submitted in writing, filed with the Commission, and served on all parties of record.
