ORDER NO. 5  
DEEMING APPLICATION DEFICIENT AND  
PROVIDING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's April 20, 2018, recommendation that Windthorst Water Supply Corporation's application remains administratively incomplete, because the application still contains material deficiencies that had been identified in Commission Staff's recommendation on March 1, 2018.


In accordance with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application remains deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8, applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission. Additionally, Windthorst should not issue notice until the application is found administratively complete.

On or before May 3, 2018, Windthorst shall supplement the application to cure the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff on March 1, 2018. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested information is received and reviewed.

On or before May 17, 2018, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule if appropriate.
