

Pg 3 of 25 or 4 of 92- To clarify there are 3 separate areas in which we are requesting to add to our CCN. The total acreage of those areas is 425 acres. This information is more specifially addressed in the Legal 5647 notice. Area 1 and 2 are existing areas in which we currently have 3 customers served. These areas are places we need to include. Area 3 is for one new customer. All cost for new line are being paid by new customer and there is an immediate need for water service. The Windthorst Water Supply will not be effected in any way as far as expense and this new Area 3 is solely for one single customer.

Windthorst Water Supply Corp. has filed an application for a CCN / to amend CCN No. 11355/with the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission to provide water utility service in Archer and Clay Counties.

AREA #1

Beginning at a point in the South line of the existing CCN Boundary, said point is 500 feet East of the centerline of McMurtry Road and 580 feet South of its intersection with the centerline of Loftin Road for the Northeast corner and Place of Beginning of this description:

THENCE South parallel to and 500 feet East of the centerline of McMurtry Road for a distance of 6800 feet to a point for an angle corner of this description;

THENCE Southeast parallel to and 500 feet East of the centerline of McMurtry Road a distance of 3900 feet to a point for the most Southerly Southeast corner of this description;
