COMMISSION STAFF'S AMENDED FINAL RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Commission Staff's Amended Final Recommendation and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On November 3, 2017, MSEC Enterprises, Inc. (MSEC), filed an application pursuant to Tex. Admin. Code § 24.21 (TAC) with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to implement a water pass-through provision for Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12887 in Montgomery County. MSEC is under the jurisdiction of the Lone Star Groundwater Conservation District (LSGCD). Beginning January 1, 2018, LSGCD will be increasing the Water Use Fee it charges MSEC. MSEC filed this application to recover the increase in the water use fee imposed upon them by LSGCD.

On November 8, 2017, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued an order setting November 27, 2017 as the deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on MSEC's application, sufficiency of notice and propose a procedural schedule.

On November 27, 2017, Staff filed a recommendation on MSEC's application, sufficiency of notice and proposed a procedural schedule, but inadvertently forgot to attach the revised tariff.

II. STAFF'S AMENDED RECOMMENDATION

This pleading includes the revised tariff associated with Docket No. 47757 and corrects the inadvertent exclusion of the tariff in Staff's November 27, 2017 filing.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests that an order be issued consistent with this Recommendation.

PURCHASED WATER AND/OR DISTRICT FEE PASS THROUGH CLAUSE:

Changes in fees imposed by any non-affiliated third party water supplier or underground water district having jurisdiction over the Utility shall be passed through as an adjustment to the water gallonage charge according to the following formula:

AG = G + B/(1-L)

Where:

AG = adjusted gallonage charge, rounded to the nearest one cent

G = approved gallonage charge (per 1,000 gallons)

B = change in purchased water/district gallonage charge (per 1,000 gallons)
L = system average line loss for the preceding 12 months not to exceed 0.15
