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

RE: Tariff Control No. 47757 – Application of MSEC Enterprises, Inc. for a Pass-Through Rate Change

NOTICE OF APPROVAL

This Notice addresses MSEC Enterprises, Inc.'s application for a pass-through rate to recover the increase in the water use fee imposed on the utility by the Lone Star Groundwater Conservation District beginning January 1, 2018. The pass-through rate affects several subdivisions in Grimes and Montgomery Counties. MSEC's requested effective date for the pass-through rate change is also January 1, 2018.

On November 27, 2017, Commission Staff filed a recommendation for approval of MSEC's requested pass-through rate of \$0.12 per 1,000 gallons, effective January 1, 2018, consistent with the attached memorandum of Jolie Mathis of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, MSEC's application and tariff with the new pass-through rate of \$0.12 per 1,000 gallons is approved effective January 1, 2018. The approved tariff pages for MSEC are attached to this Notice.

PURCHASED WATER AND/OR DISTRICT FEE PASS THROUGH CLAUSE:

Changes in fees imposed by any non-affiliated third party water supplier or underground water district having jurisdiction over the Utility shall be passed through as an adjustment to the water gallonage charge according to the following formula:

AG = G + B/(1-L)

Where:

AG = adjusted gallonage charge, rounded to the nearest one cent

G = approved gallonage charge (per 1,000 gallons)

B = change in purchased water/district gallonage charge (per 1,000 gallons)

L = system average line loss for the preceding 12 months not to exceed 0.15
