Minor Tariff Revisions to the Water Utility Tariff of MSEC Enterprises, Inc.,

CCN No. 12887

To Whom It May Concern:

Please accept this letter as a request for a minor tariff change on behalf of MSEC Enterprises, Inc. ("MSEC"). This request is being made pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.21(b)(2)(A)(ix)(I) and (II).

The current tariff on file for MSEC (CCN No. 12887) includes a listing of subdivisions and public water supply ("PWS") system identification numbers. This listing is out of date and needs to be revised in the following respects (a red-lined listing of subdivisions and PWS ID numbers is attached as Attachment 1, with identification of the explanation for each change as listed below). As described below, MSEC currently operates three systems: Montgomery Trace PWS ID No. 1700638; Stillwater PWS ID No. 1700677; and Crown Ranch PWS ID No. 1700781. The changes needed are as follows:

- (1) The Highland Ranch Water System, PWS ID No. 170614, was merged with the Lake Forest Lodge Water System, PWS ID No. 1700018, in 2007. Attached as Attachment 2 is a letter dated July 23, 2007, from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality acknowledging this merger and noting that the Highland Ranch Water System, ID No. 1700614, will be dissolved.
- (2) The Lake Forest Lodge Water System, PWS ID No. 1700018, was inactivated in 2015, and all of the subdivisions within that system are now being served by the Montgomery Trace Water System, PWS ID No. 1700638. Attached as Attachment 3 is a letter dated April 28, 2015, from the TCEQ noting that the Lake Forest Lodge Subdivision PWS ID No. 1700018 has been inactivated.
- (3) The subdivision identified as "Elk Trace Golf Course" should be removed, and a subdivision identified as "Woodforest" should be added. The Elk Trace Golf Course was purchased by the new owner of the Woodforest development, and is therefore included in the Woodforest subdivision, which is served by the Montgomery Trace System, PWS ID No. 1700638. ("Elk Trace Golf Estates" should remain on the list.)

- (4) A new subdivision identified as "Legacy Creek Estates" should be added to the list. This is a new subdivision developed in the last several years within CCN No. 12887. It is served by the Montgomery Trace System, PWS ID No. 1700638.
- (5) "Old Kentucky Farms" should be added to the list. This subdivision was developed within CCN No. 12887 years ago, but has been omitted from the list for unknown reasons. It is served by the Montgomery Trace System, PWS ID No. 1700638.
- (6) "Woodforest Golf Course" should be added to the list. As noted above, the name of this golf course changed with the new owner. The golf course itself has been in CCN No. 12887 for a number of years, but just recently became a customer of MSEC when a new clubhouse was built that required fire flow, which is provided by MSEC. It is served by the Montgomery Trace System, PWS ID No. 1700638
- (7) "Valleywood Acres" is served by the Montgomery Trace System, PWS ID No. 1700638. The current list erroneously indicates service by the Stillwater Water System, PWS ID No. 1700677. Valleywood Acres has never been served by the Stillwater system.

Enclosed as Attachment 4 is a correct listing of all of the subdivisions and PWS ID numbers for the water systems owned and operated by MSEC within CCN No. 12887, as well as a map (Attachment 5) showing the locations of the three current PWS. MSEC requests that this corrected listing be approved and added to the official tariff on file with the Commission so that the official tariff accurately reflects the subdivisions and PWS ID numbers.

Dear Mr. Browne:

Your June 4, 2007 letter of notification for the proposed waterline connection to and the merger with Lake Forest Lodge WS has been received and reviewed. The proposed surviving system will be the Lake Forest Lodge Water System, ID No. 1700018, and the Highland Ranch Water System, ID No. 170614, will be dissolved.

Construction of the waterline connection may commence after our review and approval of final engineering construction plans and specifications. Please note also that Ms. Tammy Benter with the Utilities Financial Review Team must also be notified if the merger of the two systems affects the certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) of either water system.



Dear Mr. Kelton:

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has received documentation indicating that the Lake Forest Lodge Subdivision public water system is receiving water for human consumption from the Montgomery Trace Water System public water system. The TCEQ has also received your request to inactivate the Lake Forest Lodge Subdivision public water system. Based on our review, the Lake Forest Lodge Subdivision public water system has been inactivated in accordance with Title 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC), Sections 290.38(66) and 290.102(a)(1)-(5). As a result of this regulatory status change, the Lake Forest Lodge Subdivision is not required to implement state and federal drinking water standards and rule requirements.

The TCEQ is responsible for ensuring that public water systems provide the public with safe and adequate drinking water in compliance with state and federal drinking water standards and rule requirements. If the regulatory status of your facility changes, you must notify the TCEQ so that it may be re-evaluated for compliance purposes.

On September 1, 2014, the TCEQ transferred responsibility for the water utility rate, Sale, Transfer, and Merger and Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) programs to the Public Utility Commission (PUC) of Texas. This transfer was required by the PUC's 2013 Sunset legislation (House Bill 1600). After the transfer, the PUC will be responsible for the regulation of submetered or allocated utility service. If an owner intends to bill tenants for submetered or allocated utility service, the owner must register with the PUC.
