COMMISSION STAFF'S AMENDED FINAL RECOMMENDATION

§ §

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Amended Final Recommendation. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On November 3, 2017, MSEC Enterprises, Inc. (MSEC) filed an application to implement a water pass-through provision for certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 12887 (Tariff Control No. 47757). On November 8, 2017, MSEC filed an application for approval of minor tariff revisions, specifically to update the list of subdivisions and public water identification numbers owned and operated by MSEC within CNN No. 12887 (Tariff Control No. 47762).

On November 27, 2017, Staff filed a final recommendation regarding Tariff Control No. 47762 in this docket to recommend approval of the tariff recommended for approval in Commission Staff's Final Recommendation in Tariff Control No. 47757.² On November 29, 2017, Staff filed an amended final recommendation in Tariff Control No. 47757.³ The amended final recommendation in Tariff Control No. 47757 included an attachment of a tariff which differs from the tariff attached to the final recommendation in Tariff Control No. 47762 in two ways on page 2. First, the amount of the San Jacinto River Authority (SJRA) pass-through fee

was updated to \$2.93 per 1,000 gallons. Second, the citation to the tariff control number authorizing the SJRA pass-through fee was updated to Tariff Control No. 47465.

II. FINAL RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of the tariff attached to Staff's amended final recommendation in Tariff Control No. 47757, as it incorporates all changes to CCN No. 12887 requested in this docket, Tariff Control No. 47762. Staff notes that the new tariff removes Elk Trace Golf Estates from the list of subdivisions, as that area is included within the subdivision Woodforest, which has been added to the new tariff.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests that the administrative law judge issue an order consistent with Staff's amended final recommendations in Tariff Control Nos. 47762 and 47757.
