COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Recommendation. In support thereof, Staff would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On November 13, 2017, Woodland Oaks Utility Company, Inc. (Woodland Oaks), Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 10348, filed an application for a pass-through rate change pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.21 (TAC). Specifically, Woodland Oaks requested approval of a pass-through rate increase to recover the increase of the water use fee to be imposed on the utility by the Lone Star Groundwater Conservation District (LSGCD) beginning January 1, 2018. Woodland Oaks's proposed effective date is January 1, 2018.

Notice Setting Deadline for Staff's Recommendation, issued on November 15, 2017, required Staff to file a recommendation by December 4, 2017. This pleading is timely filed.

II. STAFF'S RECOMMENDATIONS

Staff has reviewed Woodland Oaks's application and proposed notice in light of the requirements of 16 TAC § 24.21(b)(2)(E) and determined they comply with the applicable rules. Staff recommends both be deemed sufficient. Furthermore, as supported by the attached memorandum of Brannon Pennick of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, Staff recommends approval of Woodland Oaks's application for a pass-through rate increase. Staff also recommends that Woodland Oaks be provided a copy of the updated tariff and that an order granting the application contain the following language: "If Woodland Oaks collects an amount as a result of the proposed rate increase that is higher than the fees charged by LSGCD, then Woodland Oaks must refund any amounts collected in excess of the charges made to Woodland Oaks Utility Company, Inc. by LSGCD for the expenses passed through."

III. COMMENTS ON PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

In accordance with the recommendation for approval of Woodland Oaks's pass-through rate increase, Staff does not propose a procedural schedule.

IV. CONCLUSION

Staff recommends approval of Woodland Oaks's application for a pass-through rate change.

On November 13, 2017, Woodland Oaks Utility Company, Inc. (Woodland Oaks or Applicant), Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12947, filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to implement an adjustment to one of its pass-through fees pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.21. The pass-through adjustment is for 2018 mandatory pumpage fees billed by the Lone Star Groundwater Conservation District (LSGCD) as part of the Groundwater Reduction Plan. Woodland Oaks serves the subdivisions Woodland Oaks and Forest West.

LSGCD's rate increase will be effective on January 1, 2018. Woodland Oaks provided calculations and requests an increase of their current LSGCD pass-through to \$0.12 per 1,000 gallons per month.

Staff recommends that the Commission:

- 1) Deem the application sufficient for filing;
- 2) Approve the pass-through increase requested in the application;
- 3) Provide a copy of the approved tariff to the Applicant (attached);
- 4) Include the following language in the order: "If Woodland Oaks collects an amount as a result of the proposed rate increase that is higher than the fees charged by LSGCD, then Woodland Oaks must refund any amounts collected in excess of the charges made to Woodland Oaks Utility Company, Inc. by LSGCD for the expenses passed through."

PURCHASED WATER AND/OR DISTRICT FEE PASS THROUGH CLAUSE:

Changes in fees imposed by any non-affiliated third party water supplier or underground water district having jurisdiction over the Utility shall be passed through as an adjustment to the water gallonage charge according to the following formula:

AG = G+B/(1-L)

Where:

AG = adjusted gallonage charge, rounded to the nearest one cent

G = approved gallonage charge (per 1,000 gallons)

B = change in purchased water/district gallonage charge (per 1,000 gallons)

L = system average line loss for the preceding 12 months not to exceed 0.15

To implement or modify the pass through provision, the utility must comply with all notice and other requirements of 30 TAC 24.21(h).

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
