NOW COMES Guadalupe Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("GVEC") and files this Motion to Intervene in the above-referenced docket in accordance with 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 22.103 and § 22.104, and in support thereof would show the following:

1. On November 15, 2017, the Legal Division of the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission") filed Commission Staff's Application to Set 2018 Wholesale Transmission Service Charges for the Electric Reliability Council of Texas ("ERCOT").

2. GVEC is the owner of transmission facilities, providing transmission service within the ERCOT and is an ERCOT transmission customer. Accordingly, GVEC will be affected by the transmission service charges set in this Docket. GVEC has participated in prior annual proceedings which set ERCOT wholesale transmission charges. Thus in accordance with 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 22.103, GVEC has justiciable interest in the outcome of this proceeding and the transmission service charges that are the subject of this docket.

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


