Please accept this as a formal request for inclusion in a formal hearing and to be an intervener regarding the City of Hutto application for CCN 20122, docket # 47795 for property tax ID#R019452 and ID#R020015.

We are adjacent to the property Hutto is proposing to impose as a service area. We did not receive notification of any meetings. The only way we found out is through our neighbors. Also neighbors in the proposed area who have more than 25 acres did not receive the first letter or the 2<sup>nd</sup> letter correcting the first letter.

The meeting that we attended was dysfunctional, the city attorney, Phil Haag, did not even know that 15,600+ acres was even considered. The maps provided at the meeting were not showing individual properties. The notice states that the service area is approximately 3 miles in direction of downtown Hutto. The property they are specifying is way past 3 miles (5 miles our case). Thre is not a clear date specified and when questioned, the entire group of people who handled the meeting could not answer any questions we had. They promised to email us the answers to all our questions and to date, have not heard from them. Helen Ramirez was one of these people. No one else has received answers to any questions either.

The City of Hutto has repeatedly been exceedingly misleading and secretive regarding what plans that they have. They intentionally are confusing and lack any transparency in their dealings.

Please grant us an extension of time to gather any information needed to formally request a hearing.
