

SOAH ORDER NO 6
EXTENDING TIME FOR MEDIATION

In order No. 5, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) referred this case to SOAH's Alternative Dispute Resolution Team Leader, Judge Howard S. Seitzman, for mediation between Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas, the City of Hutto, and the Boehm Alliance. The ALJ ordered that the case shall be returned to the ALJ by September 28, 2018, unless extended by order of the presiding ALJ. On September 28, 2018, the City of Houston filed a report on the status of the mediation and an unopposed request to extend the deadline for returning the file to the ALJ to October 26, 2018. In support, the City of Hutto stated the parties had reached agreement but needed additional time to finalize the settlement documents.

The ALJ finds the request to extend the deadline has merit and it is **GRANTED**. The parties shall submit a status report or a motion to dismiss no later than **October 26, 2018**.
