JOINT REQUEST FOR PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) and the City of Hutto (Hutto) and files this Joint Request for a Procedural Schedule and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On November 21, 2017, Hutto filed an application to amend its sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity number 20122, in Williamson County, Texas (Application). On February 27, 2018, the proceeding was referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH). On August 23, 2018, the SOAH Administrative Law Judge (SOAH ALJ) issued Order No. 5 and referred the proceeding to SOAH's Alternative Dispute Resolution Team Leader, Judge Howard S. Seitzman. On August 20, 2018, Judge Seitzman held a mediation at which Staff, Hutto, and several individuals who had protested and/or requested a contested case hearing on the Application (Parties) reached an agreement in principle that would have the effect of leaving only Staff and Hutto as the parties to any hearing that might be held on the Application.

On August 24, 2018, Judge Seitzman filed the Mediator's Initial Report on Mediation, reporting that the Parties had reached an agreement in principle, that the Parties were submitting the agreement to their respective principals for approval and execution, and that the mediation would remain open and assigned to the mediator pending the execution of the settlement documents. In Order No. 5, the SOAH ALJ stated that the case would be returned to the SOAH ALJ by September 28, 2018, unless extended by order of Judge Seitzman. On September 6, 2018, the Hutto City Council approved the settlement terms agreed to by the Parties. The Parties subsequently asked for several extensions to finalize the settlement documents, which were granted by the SOAH ALJ. The Mediator's Final Report on Mediation was filed on February 6,

2019 and the SOAH ALJ provided an extension of time to February 20, 2019, before the proceeding was to be returned to the SOAH ALJ. On February 20, 2019, Hutto subsequently requested the deadline to be extended to February 27, 2019. On February 25, 2019, the Boehm Alliance filed their Motion to Withdraw Protests and on February 26, 2019, Hutto reported that the settlement agreement was fully executed.

II. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Accordingly, Hutto and Staff submit this Joint Request for Procedural Schedule pursuant to which a final decision on the Application will be reached.
