**Ratepayers Response to Staff's First Request for Information  
Question No. Staff 1 – 1 Continued**

I reviewed the monthly reports provided by Raywood Water Supply Corporation to the DOD and visitors present at the monthly meetings. The Reports were for: June 1 – 30<sup>th</sup>, October 1 – 31<sup>st</sup>, and December 1 – 29<sup>th</sup>. The meters read and charged for water usage for June was 490, for October was 486 and for December was 483. A copy of the page with this information from each monthly RWSC report is included for your review. The number of ratepayers affected by this water rate increase ( 519 ) previously reported to you by RWSC appears to be incorrect based on the actual monthly readings provided each month.

The actual number of meters read which incurred charges as reported by RWSC each month would indicate that the Petition by the Ratepayers of Raywood Water Supply Corporation has met the required number of member signatures to allow the Rate Appeal to continue. It is our hope that the Petition by the Ratepayers of RWSC will prevail and that some relief from the near doubling of our rates will be granted.


Another interesting fact from the afore mentioned RWSC Monthly Reports is the number of rate payers who is delinquent and as a result incur additional expense each month. The highest percent of late payers apparently comes from the customers who use the least amount of water each month. These percentages are: June 25%, October 27% and December 34%. This added expense is causing much harm to the customers of RWSC who can least afford any increase in their cost of living.

These rate payers are paying more each month and are penalized because they have to juggle funds to meet this water charge. They must pay for water used plus the added expense of late charges. I consider this to be grossly unfair and I hope relief will soon come for those who are being hurt the most!

I hate to think about the expense of RWSC ratepayers as we approach warmer weather which will almost certainly cause water usage to increase, adding more expense to all ratepayers and especially those least able to pay.

Regrettable, I was unable to get the January bills from RWSC after asking for the copies in the meeting on January 29<sup>th</sup> and sending a registered letter which they should have received on January 30<sup>th</sup> with the request. The bills show that these were active accounts that the petitioners signed for the owners. We hope that these petitioners will be counted in the Ratepayers totals.
